10:50 am arrival at Ulm, Sonnenstrasse (change here into bus line 11)

10:56 am departure at Sonnenstrasse with line 11, direction Roter Berg

Arrival 11:03 am arrival at bus stop St.-Jakob-Strasse (leave bus here)

Walking distance to mosque: appr. 1 minute around the corner, backyard, see also the link to Google: [bird view on morque](#) □ (press STRG and click left mouse button)
