However, it is far less crowded than the other two and offers an additional attraction of geological interest - being located in the crater of a meteorite impact and with its impressive tower being built of the rock formed from that impact. We will have the opportunity to go on the walkway of the city wall and to visit the Rieskrater-Museum.
