Excursion to the city of Ravensburg visiting the famous medieval old town and followed by a visit of the Dornier Museum

In two weeks the ASSIST team will perform an excursion to the romantic old town of Ravensburg. Ravensburg. "The city of towers and gates" is situated between Lake Constance and Allgaeu in a scenic landscape with a view of the Alps. In the past, the city was a major, medieval commercial centre. Today, with its 50,000 residents, it is the lively, economic hub of Upper Swabia and an attractive holiday destination.

Ravensburg today

Rising high above the roofs of Ravensburg, the Blaserturm marks the town's centre. From the top of the tower, visitors can enjoy breathtaking views of the surrounding countryside as far as Lake Constance and the Alps or look down on the brightly coloured roofs of the old town below. Down on the town's main square Marienplatz, the narrow streets and alleys round about teem with life. People stroll through the traffic-free square or relax in one of the many street cafés; young and old meet for a chat at the fountains. It is a colourful pageant in which people lingering at leisure mingle with the hustle and bustle of everyday life. In the warm months of the year, Ravensburg exudes a Mediterranean flair.

- Expenses of excursion: You pay only the transportation cost of beween 10,00 to 15,00 € depending on the number of participants. We share the cost of the Württemberg-Ticket.

- Return time in Ulm at 17:53 p.m.
- Student-ID card: Please bring your student-ID card along to get the reduced fees for the museum.
- Food and drinks: After the guided tour we will make a two hours break after 11:00 h, then you may explore the city on your own and find some food in restaurants and on the farmers market.

 Of course you may also bring your own food with you.

 The number of participants is limited to 20 students and 5 Senior Consultants for managing reasons. Students will be preferred to all other persons (friends, relatives).
