



Invitation to an excursion to Zwiefalten Abbey and Wimsen cave on Saturday June, 17th, 2017

in behalf of ASSIST we would like to invite you to a day trip by private cars to the Cathedral of Zwiefalten and the Wimsen Cave, one hour west of Ulm.

The Cathedral is one of the most important churches in South Germany in artistic terms. From the Cathedral to the Wimsen Cave we will hike easily in about one hour. Wimsen cave is the only one in Germany to visit by boat. Near the cave there is a restaurant, but you can bring your own lunch with you.

We will be back at Ulm at about 5 pm latest.

Costs: 4 – 5 € (entrance fee for the cave, depending on the participants)
